of the International Young Physicists' Tournament**

1. The complaints (two written – from USA and Brazil teams – as well as one oral – from Australia and Switzerland) have been considered. The EC has suggested that from 2008 each country (also the host country) should be represented by one team only.
2. The Executive Committee has recommended the LOC to take 90% of the average score of the three best teams (finalists) as the lower limit for the “third Place”.
3. There have been two letters, from the United States Association for Young Physicists Tournaments and from Austrian Association “AYPT – Forschungsforum junger Physiker” requesting a written recognition from the IYPT. The Executive Committee stressed that a prerequisite for such a recognition of a national organization by the IYPT should be that the requesting organization secures free access for students from the whole country in its statutes.
4. The agenda for the IOC meeting on 12th July is being prepared.
