*Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure*

The team of Ukraine representative on the IYPT is forming on the basis of the results of the final battle in the final phase of the All-Ukrainian young physicists' tournament. Before the final phase there are qualifying battles as local YPTs in each region of the country.

The final stage includes a number of additional events besides the main competition:

- It is individual championship for personal performance of the participants: here costs only evaluation of reports and oppositions during the qualifying fights. The absolute winner in this nomination is awarded with a premium and receives bonuses on admission to universities in Ukraine.
- On subjects of the tournament's problems an individual Olympiad is carried for all participants, here the winners are determined separately from the team battles.
- Another competition is "The Hors Concours Report". In there participants report the problems that they would like to report but during the qualifying battles haven't gotten that opportunity. According to the voting procedure where the judges are the students themselves the best reports are determined.

In the main competition there are five qualified battles. The best 3 or 4 teams (depending on the number of participants) meet in the final battle.

For the final fight an organizing committee offers the choice of new problems which the finalists solve during 5 hours alone without the involvement of team-leaders. All equipment needed for experiments provided by the organizers.

The battle begins with the draw of the teams where participants need to explain 5-7 events that are demonstrated to them in a real time. The winner in the final battle gets the right to represent Ukraine on the IYPT.
